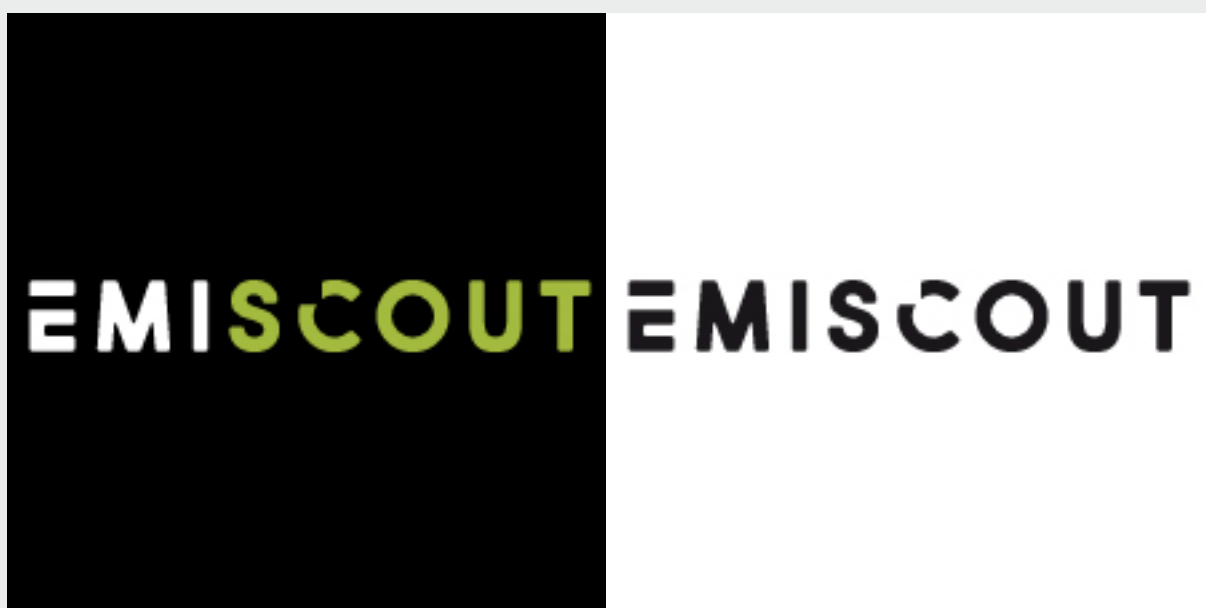

The enterprise **EMISIA S.A.** based in **Thessaloniki, Greece** region, has joined the action of national scope "RESEARCH – CREATE – INNOVATE" with the project "Development of a low cost real time emissions measurement system" (project acronym: "ReTEMS (Real Time Emissions Measurement System)", project code: T2ΕΔΚ-01576), under the Special Service for the Management and Implementation of Actions in the fields of Research, Technological Development and Innovation.

The total budget of the project is 245.125 € out of which 193.700 € is public expenditure.

The project is co-financed by the European Regional Development Fund of the European Union and Greek national funds through the Operational Program Competitiveness, Entrepreneurship and Innovation, under the call RESEARCH – CREATE – INNOVATE.

The aim of the project is the development of a portable gas and particle concentration measurement device which implements commercially available cheap sensor and a novel exhaust gas sampling system from ICE equipped vehicles like cars, trucks and ships.
